Professor Junbiao Chang, the Editor-in-chief of 'LIFE SCIENCE JOURNAL', was born in 1965 in Henan Province, P.R. China, and received his B.S. in Chemistry at Henan University in 1986. He then studied with professors Rongfeng Chen and Tianli Wang at Henan Institute of Chemistry, Henan Academy of Sciences, where he received his M.S. in 1989. He studied with Professor Jingxi Xie at Institute of Meteria Medica, Chinese Academy of Medical Sciences, where he received his Ph.D. in 1995. After postdoctoral fellowships with Professor C. K. Chu at the University of Georgia, Professor Kang Zhao at Genomics Institute of Novartis Research Foundation (USA), and Professor Yangjie Wu at Zhengzhou University of China, he joined the faculty at Henan Institute of Chemistry in China. From 1999 to 2002 he was professor and director of the Henan Institute of Chemistry. In 2003, he moved to Vice President of Xinxiang Medical College and director of Henan Key Laboratory of Fine Chemicals. Since 2006, he has been Vice President of Zhengzhou University, and visiting professor at Tianjin University and University of Science and Technology of China.

His research interests include the development of selective and efficient synthetic methodologies and the design of practical syntheses of natural products such as lignans and alkaloids and their application to biologically active systems. His has received several state awards. He has been the author/co-authors of 9 books, and has published around 200 scientific papers. He is also an associate editor of 'Spectroscopy and Spectral Analysis'.
